**(max 120 words):** Emmy De Buck (°20/02/1979) obtained her Master degree in Applied Sciences and a PhD in Medical Sciences at the KU Leuven (University of Leuven), Belgium. In 2009 she started her career at the Belgian Red Cross-Flanders where she was co-founder of the Centre for Evidence-Based Practice (CEBaP), which provides scientific support to diverse activities of the Red Cross, including blood supply. She is currently head of CEBaP where she is responsible for developing evidence-based guidelines (both national and international) and systematic reviews, all published in peer-reviewed journals. From 2016 onwards she is appointed as Assistant Professor at the Faculty of Medicine of the KU Leuven, where she teaches Evidence-Based Practice and supports medical students in the development of systematic reviews.
