Dr. Markus M. Mueller is a consultant in transfusion medicine and hemostaseology as well as assistant medical director at the Frankfurt institute for transfusion medicine and immunohematology of the German Red Cross Blood Transfusion Service. He is the head of the department of whole blood donation at the Frankfurt institute.

Dr. Mueller is a member of the German Society for Transfusion Medicine and Immunohematology (DGTI), the International Society of Blood Transfusion (ISBT) and the Society for Thrombosis & Hemostasis Research (GTH). In addition, he serves as editor of the journal "hämotherapie".

He studied medicine at the university of Ulm medical school. After finalisation of his thesis at the department of haematology and hemostaseology, university clinics of Ulm, Germany, he began his clinical training at this department. He then joined a global pharmaceutical company and worked as a senior clinical team leader.

Since 2001, he is employed at the Frankfurt institute and was the principal investigator of clinical trials He also established an advanced training programme in transfusion medicine for clinicians in Germany. His research interests comprise among others also patient blood management (PBM) programmes, quality management in hemotherapy and continuous medical education in transfusion medicine.
