Dr. Dawn Maze is a physician in the Leukemia Program at the Princess Margaret Cancer Centre in Toronto, Canada. After completing postgraduate hematology training at Queen's University, she did a fellowship in malignant hematology and transfusion research at the University of Ottawa. She is a co-PI on two multicentre pilot trials evaluating transfusion practices in malignant hematology patients, the first evaluating prophylactic vs. therapeutic platelet transfusions in outpatients receiving non-intensive therapy for MDS and AML and the second evaluating prophylactic platelets vs. tranexamic acid in patients receiving autologous transplantation. She is also PI on a study of outcomes of AML patients receiving induction after an institutional change to a more restrictive red cell transfusion policy. She is the chair of the University Health Network Hospital Transfusion Committee.
