

Yves Ozier is Professor of Anesthesiology and Critical Care Medicine at the Western Brittany University (Université de Bretagne Occidentale) and Head of the Division of Anesthesia, Critical Care and Emergency Medicine at the University Hospital of Brest, France.

In the period 2000-2011, he was appointed as a Professor of Anesthesiology and Critical Care Medicine at the University Paris-Descartes and Head of the Department of Anesthesia and Surgical Intensive Care of the Cochin University Hospital in Paris.

His main research and teaching interests are in the field of perioperative transfusion medicine. He is a member of several scientific societies including NATA (Network for the Advancement of Patient Blood Management, Haemostasis and Thrombosis) and the French Society of Blood Transfusion.

He has acted as expert in several guidelines including the NATA guidelines on the detection, evaluation, and management of preoperative anaemia in the elective orthopaedic surgical patient and the European guidelines on Management of major bleeding and coagulopathy following trauma.
