Brief education and work history with relevant accomplishments regarding to ICC-PBM2018 (max 120 words):

Marian G.J. van Kraaij, MD, PhD, studied Medicine (1989 MD) at the University Utrecht, the Netherlands. In 1999 she was registered as a consultant in Internal Medicine, followed by registration as a consultant in hematology in 2001. She obtained her PhD on the topic of prevention of infectious diseases in stem cell transplant recipients (University of Utrecht 2003). In 2002 she became a member of the staff of the Department of Hematology of the Radboud University Nijmegen Medical Centre (RUNMC). She specialized in thrombosis and haemostasis and participated in the Haemophilia Comprehensive Care Centre of the RUNMC. In 2008 she started working at the Department of Transfusion Medicine of Sanquin Blood Bank combined with patient care at Radboudumc. She was registered as a consultant in transfusion medicine specialist in 2010. In 2013 she became Director of the national department of Transfusion Medicine of Sanquin Blood Bank and combined this in 2016 with the function of Director of department Donor Affairs. She advocates close collaboration between blood bank and hospitals to optimize both patient care and transfusion research as well as donor research (“vein to vein”). Her current research focuses on iron (either iron depletion in donors as well as secondary iron overload in patients) and anaemia (patient blood management).
