Dr Wikman is a specialist in Clinical Immunology and Transfusion Medicine and have worked in Transfusion Medicine at Karolinska University Hospital since 1989, heading both Immunhematology and blood component preparation laboratories, for many years. Her research has previously been in Immunhematology, but recently she is more and more involved in coagulation and bleeding. She is a co-writer of national guidelines in treatment of massive bleeding and massive transfusion programs have now been implemented, in all Swedish hospitals. She is author and co-author of more than 60 published articles.

Dr Wikman is the leader of a national group in PBM, currently working to implement perioperative anemia management protocols, nationally. The PBM group has initiated networks with thoracic, orthopaedic and colon cancer surgeons and involved anesthetists to discuss the routines, e.g. the preoperative anemia diagnosis and management. A national meeting is planned May 16th with invited clinicians and from consensus on that meeting an article on general recommendation in perioperative anemia management is planned to be published in the Swedish Medical Journal "Läkartidningen". Nordic collaboration on PBM have been discussed with Norway, Denmark and Finland..

The international consensus conference on PBM in Frankfurt comes very timely for the work in Sweden.
